CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL JOINT MEETING WITH LINCOLN COUNTY BOARD AND CITIES IN THE COUNTY

April 27, 2020

Approved Minutes

I. Meeting Call to Order

Lincoln County Board of Commissioners Chair Kaety Jacobson called to order the Special joint meeting of the County Board and cities in the County to order at 1:30 pm on April 27, 2020 through the City of Newport's virtual meeting platform.

Mayor W. John Moore called the April 27, 2020 special meeting of the Yachats City Council with the Lincoln County cities and Commissioners to order at 1:42 pm by participation through the City of Newport's virtual meeting platform. Council Members present: W. John Moore, Max Glenn, Mary Ellen O'Shaughnessey, Jim Tooke, and Leslie Vaaler. Staff present: City Manager Shannon Beaucaire.

II. Update from Lincoln County Health

Rebecca Austin, Incident Commander with Lincoln County Health Department, provided an update on Covid-19 responses by Lincoln County Public Health.

III. Recovery Plan for Lincoln County

Wiley Thompson, Oregon State Extension Service Regional Director for Coast Region, provided an update on their work with Lincoln County on a recovery plan.

IV. Governor's Office Plans for Reopening

Sarah Means, Oregon Regional Solutions Coordinator from the Governor's Office, explained the plan for reopening proposed by the Governor.

V. Order 4-20-118 Extending Order 3-23-85

County Counsel Wayne Belmont explained Order 4-20-118 is proposed to extend the short-term rental restrictions in 3-23-85 expiring on April 30, 2020.

Each city and the Siletz Nation provided their input on possible extension dates.

Mayor Moore stated that while he was reluctant to extend the restrictions for five weeks, he could support the extension to May 31, 2020. He noted the City had extended their Emergency Declaration to May 8, 2020 and would need to revise that to be consistent with this order. Councilors Glenn, O'Shaughnessey, Tooke, and Vaaler favored the May 31, 2020 extension. O'Shaughnessey asked that testing be expanding that the Public Health Department get involved.

The Board of Commissioners passed a motion to extend the Lincoln County emergency declaration to May 31, 2020.

Each city passed motions to extend their emergency declarations where necessary and to approve an extension of Order 3-23-85 to May 31, 2020.

Mayor Moore reported Yachats extended their emergency declaration to May 8, 2020 but gave the authority to the City Manager to extend this order. Manager Beaucaire asked that Moore take a vote of Council.

Glenn moved to extend the declaration of a state of emergency in the City of Yachats to May 31, 2020: Aye – 5; No – 0.

Vaaler moved to approve county Order 4-20-118 extending Order 3-23-85 to May 31, 2020: Aye – 5; No – 0.

The Board of Commissioners passed a motion to extend Order 3-23-85 to May 31, 2020. Belmont summarized the upcoming votes from jurisdictions not present.

Jacobsen adjourned all meetings at 3:21 pm.
