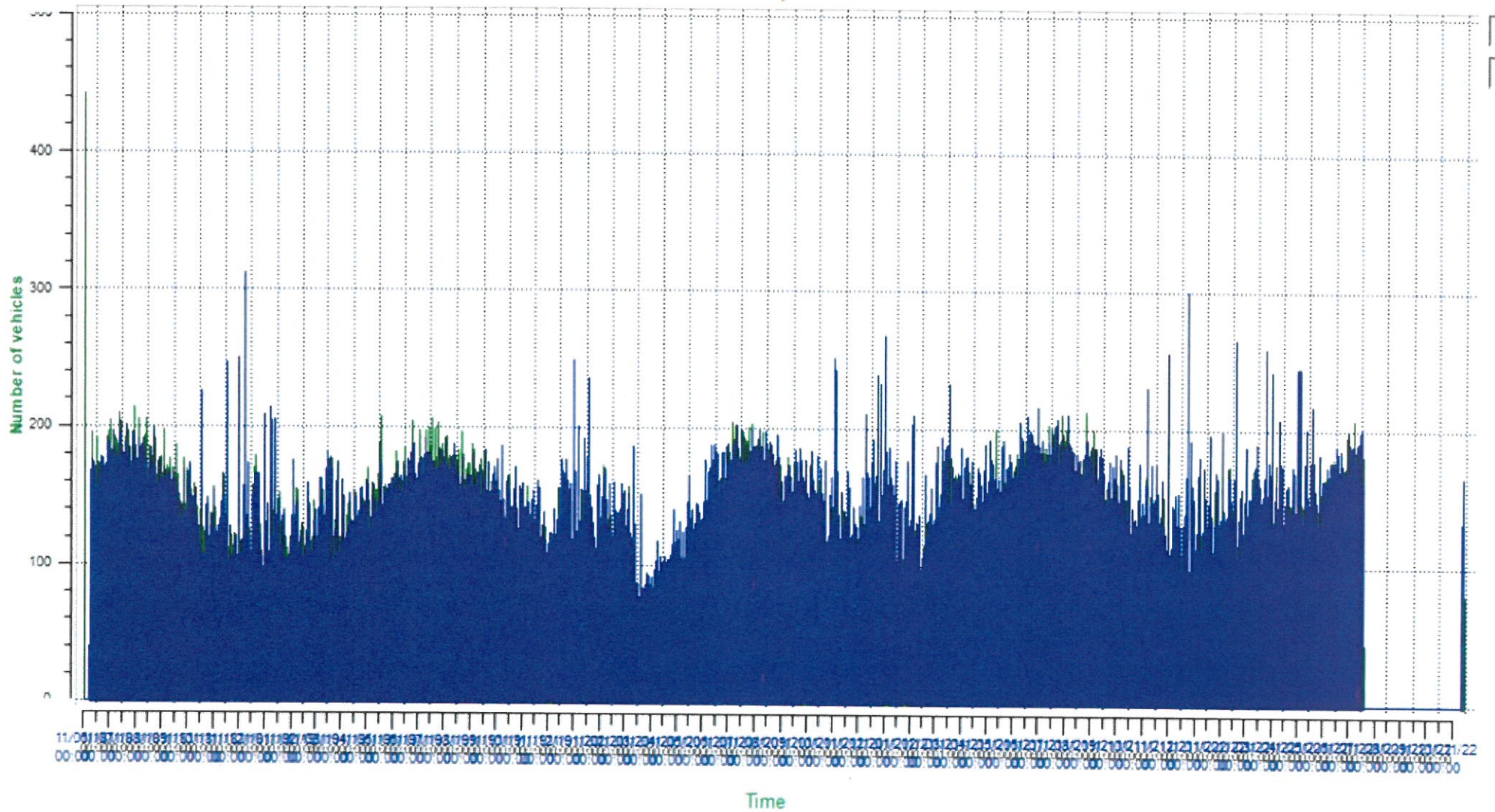

Vehicles per hour

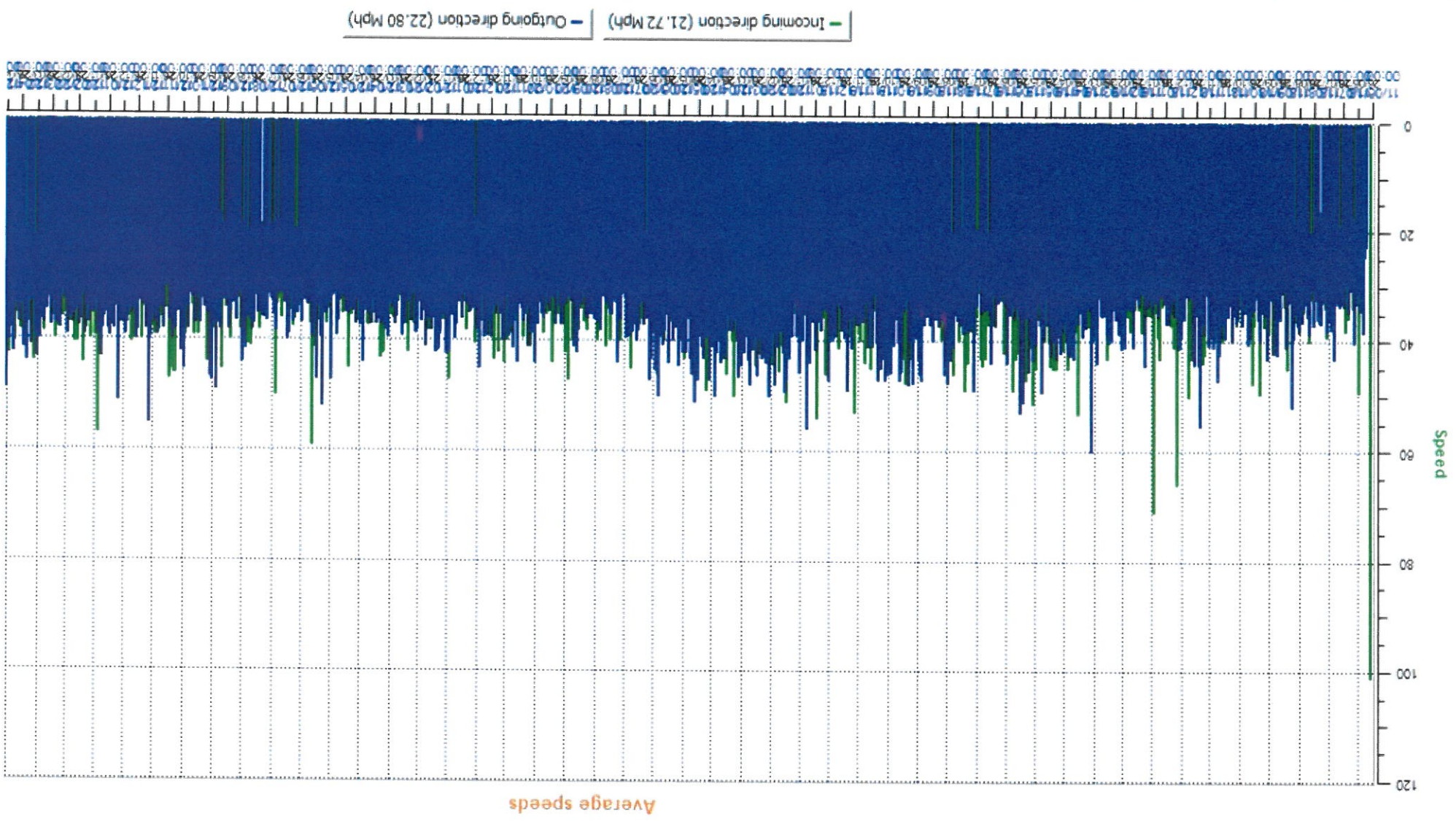

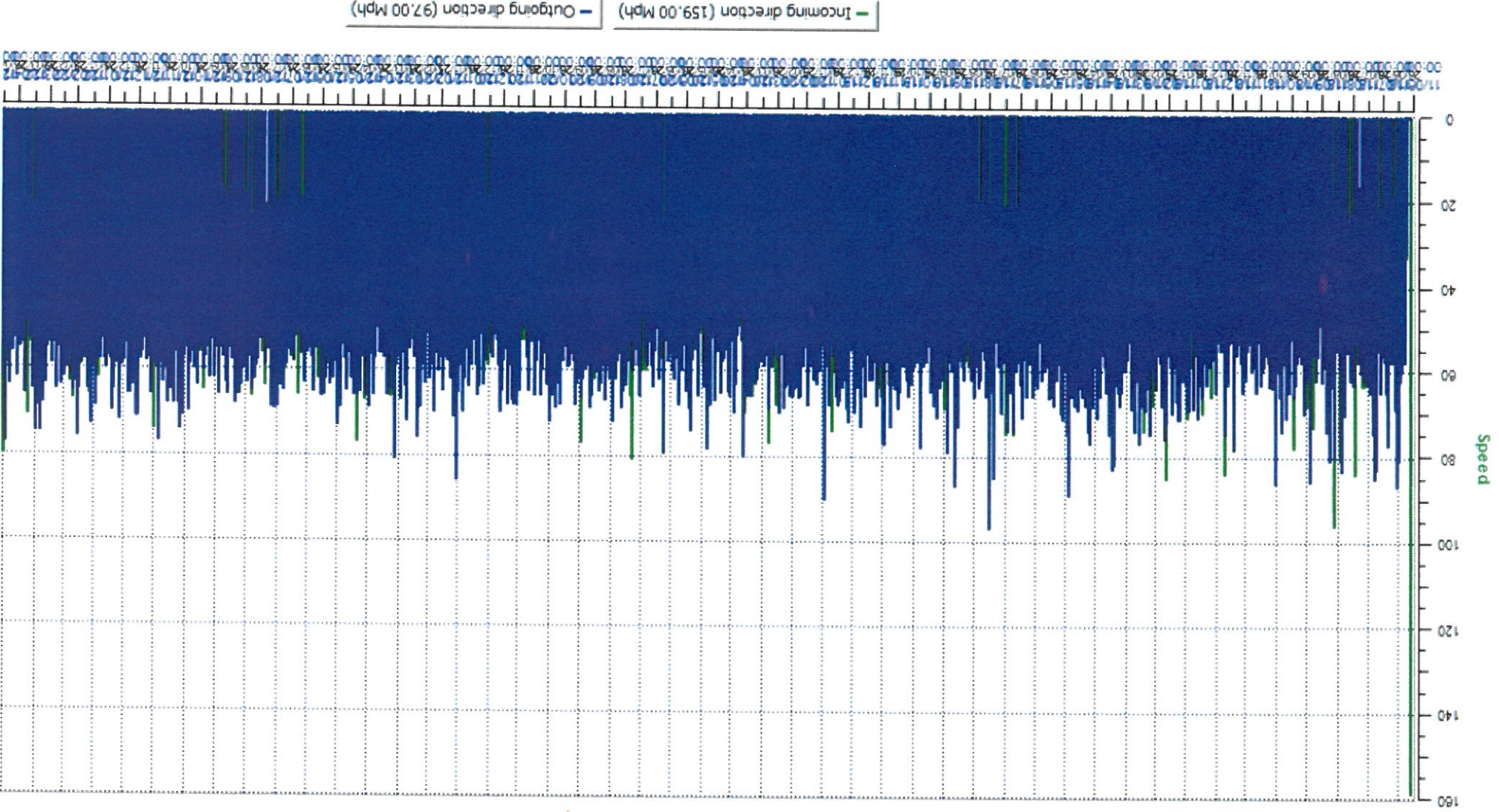

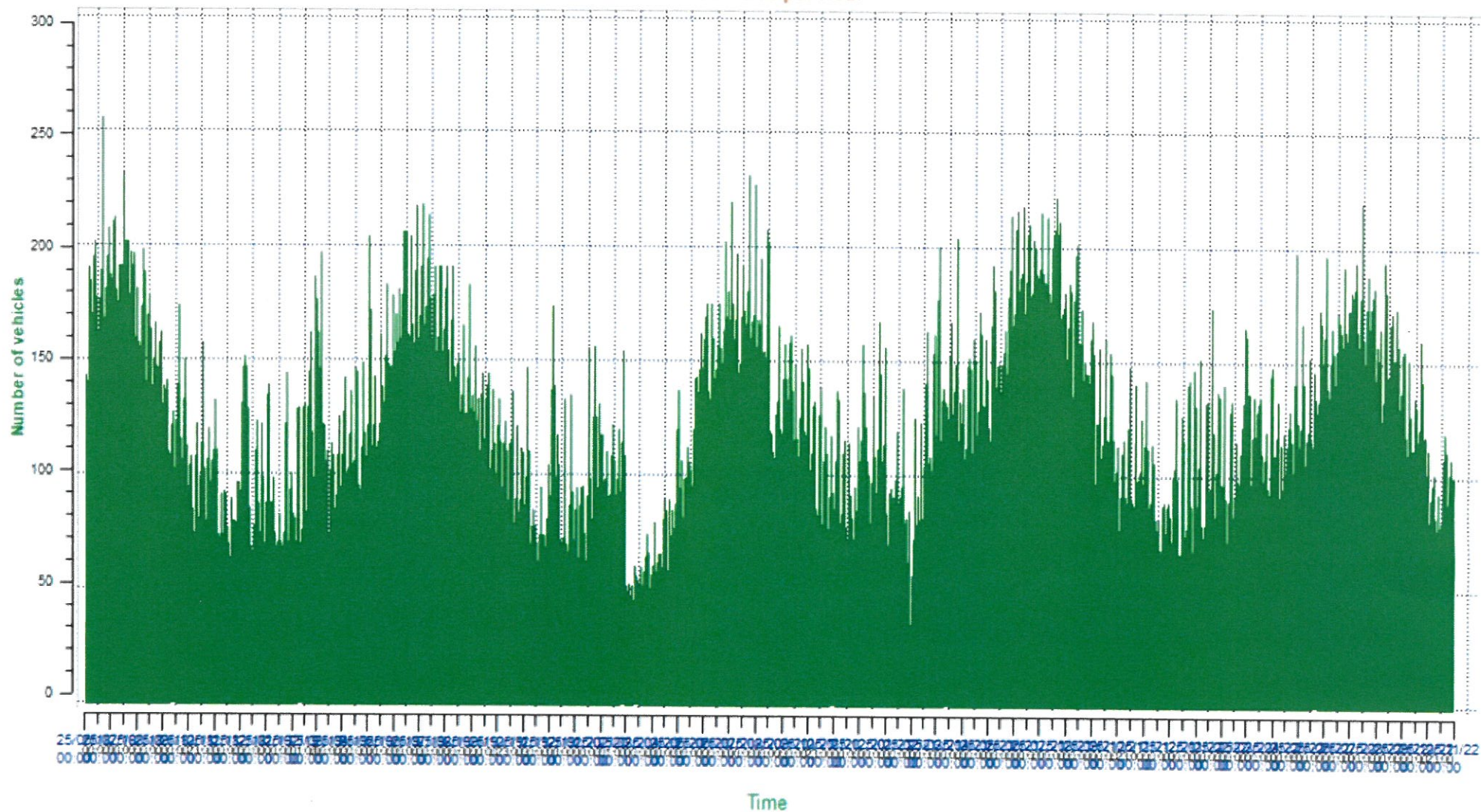


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Vehicles per hour

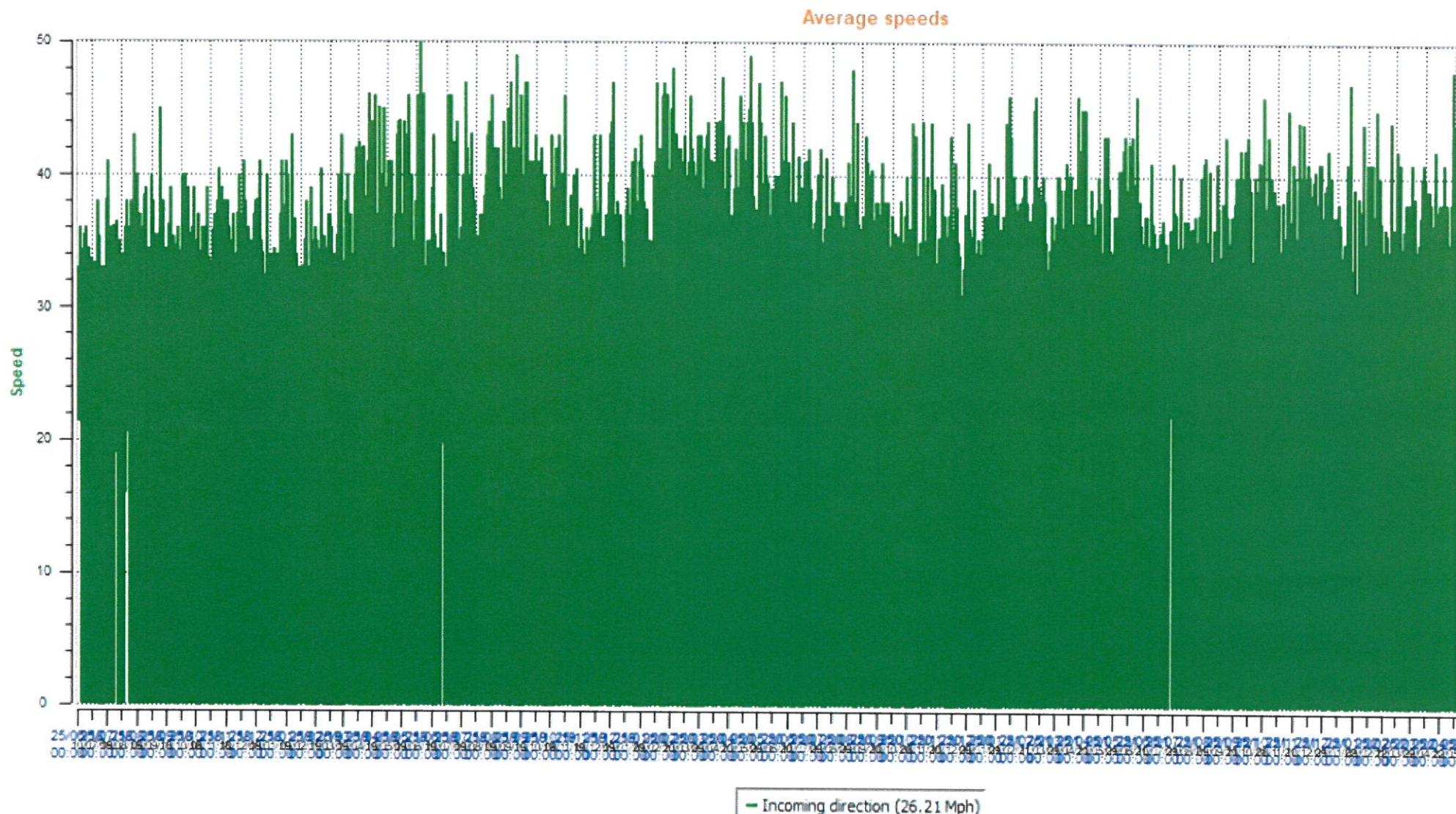

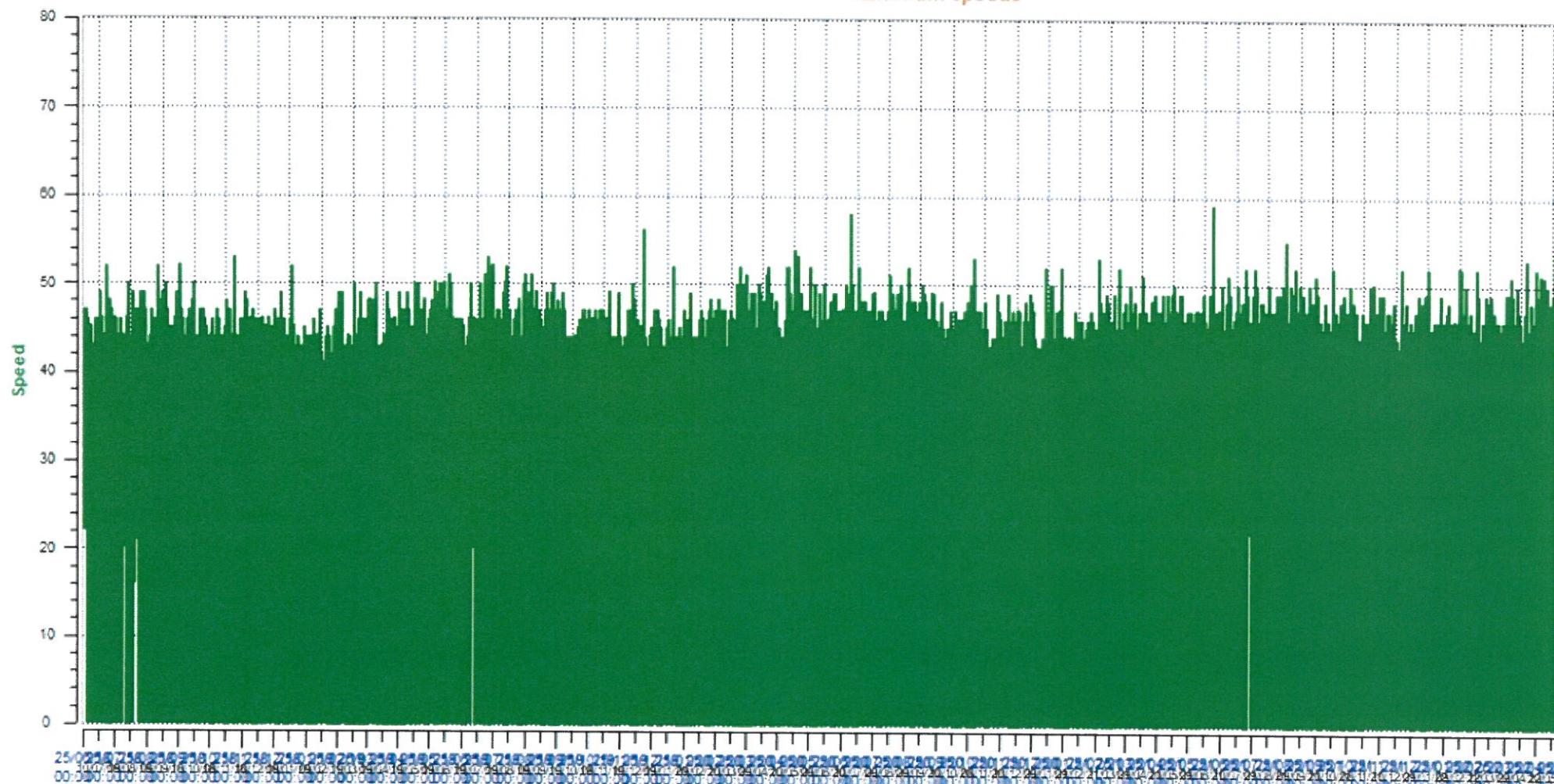


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Maximum speeds



— Incoming direction (72.00 Mph)



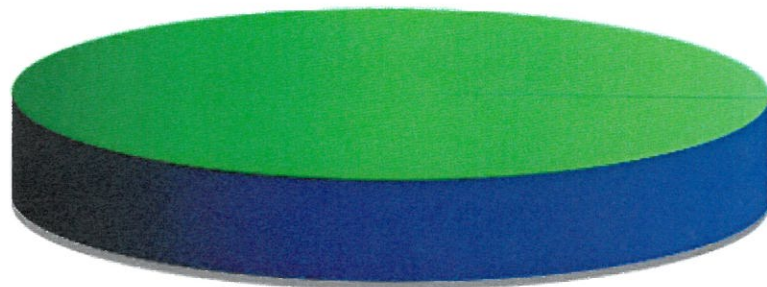
