And it might be good to purchase some additional supplies to round out our materials:

6 pop-up toilet tents

1 additional bucket toilet

2 pop-up awnings

2 camp stoves

4 large cooking pots

portable water purifiers

instant coffee, tea

trash bags

can openers

The foodstuffs in Connexes 1 & 2 either regular serving size cans or large containers (oatmeal, beans etc.) Since we're trying to help the displaced, we might want to prepare warm beverages and oatmeal under an awning near the Connex while handing out supplies.
