Minutes

Chair John Moore started the informal meeting of the June 13, 2017 meeting of the Public Works and Streets Commission at 3:10 pm in Room 1 of the Yachats Commons. Members present: Don Groth, John Moore, Doug Johnson. Absent: Marc Courtenay, Rick Haynes, Tom Bedell, Larry Nixon. Staff Present: City Clerk Kimmie Jackson. A quorum was not present.

The Commission discussed getting Jobs Corps students to help staff Clean Sweep. Commissioner Johnson explained Jobs Corps students need to be paid by check and need to be fed.

Moore asked about signage for the dumpsters. Clerk Jackson brought in laminated signs and indicated if more are needed, she can provide them. Johnson asked Jackson to review the email from Dahl about what bins would be provided. Jackson said she would be able to create signs quickly if needed during setup on Friday, June 23, 2017.

Moore stated he would send confirmation emails to Commissioners regarding staffing assignments for Clean Sweep.

Moore noted the bid was awarded to Clackamas Construction.

Commissioner Groth asked if Public Works would be responsible for monitoring landscaping and art installations are the Highway 101 Project. Moore was not certain about the assignment of responsibility. Moore reported the project should be completed by the end of June 2017.

Groth noted the F250 service truck went to Newport for repairs and emphasized the need for two vehicles for Public Works.

With no further business before the Commission, Moore adjourned the meeting at 3:25 pm.
